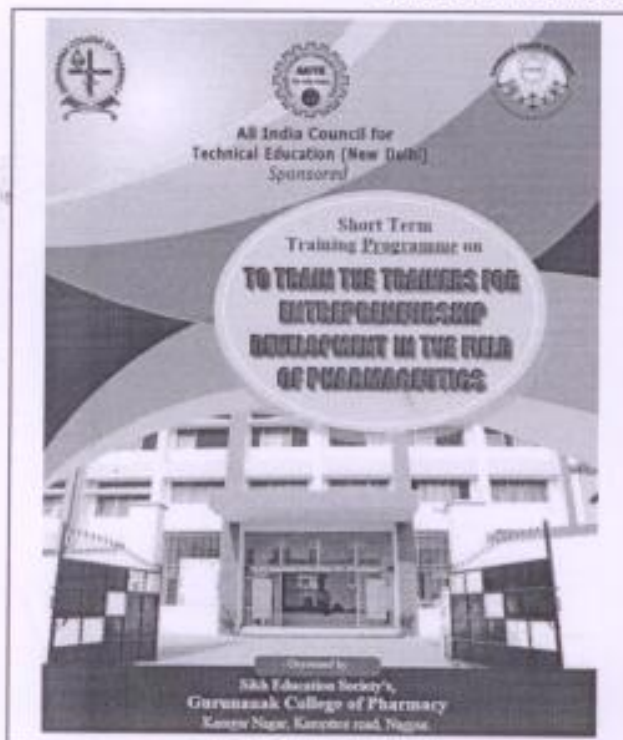

There is an ever growing efforts to apply computational power in the combined chemical and biological space in order to streamline drug discovery, design, development and optimization, to biomedical areas, computer-aided in silico design is being utilized to expedite and facilitate hit identification, hit-to-lead selection, optimize the absorption, distribution, metabolism/excretion and toxicity profile and avoid safety issues. CADD is being utilized to identify hits (active drug candidates), select lead-prior likely candidates for further evaluation, and optimize lead (i.e. transform biologically active compounds into suitable drugs by improving their physico-chemical, pharmacological, ADMET/PS, pharmaceutical) properties. Therefore faculty of academic institutions as well as students are required to be updated and trained. It should be apparent that CADD has an immense potential in today's drug development era and his skills as well as experience of computer in drug development process. This exposure and training to such recent advances in faculty and students can fulfill the requirements of Pharmaceutical industries.
