

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

- c) The detailed modalities of the working of individual projects shall be arrived at after mutual discussion and documented separately as project specific agreement / contracts before taking up the project and it shall form a part of this Agreement

3. OBLIGATIONS OF THE PARTIES:

- 3.1 The results of this agreement and research data which are collected, compiled and evaluated under this Agreement shall be shared and mutually exchanged by INNOVA, Nagpur and GNCP, Nagpur. Research findings as a result of this agreement will be published in the public interest and INNOVA, Nagpur will hold editorial rights for the same.
- 3.2 As a result of this agreement the instruments & equipments available at the respective facilities shall be shared mutually by INNOVA, Nagpur and GNCP, Nagpur.
- 3.3 Results of collaborative research may be tried on experimental and Clinical Trials and demonstrations with active participation of GNCP, Nagpur, and INNOVA, Nagpur.
- 3.4 Frequent and effective communication is essential to the successful accomplishment of the objectives of this agreement. To this end, the scientific representatives of INNOVA, Nagpur and GNCP, Nagpur, shall conduct periodical meetings (half yearly) at the premises of INNOVA, Nagpur and GNCP, Nagpur by mutual consultation of both parties.
- 3.5 This agreement may be supplemented by work plans to be developed jointly, which describe more specifically the activities to be carried out under this cooperative programme and which sets forth the envisaged contribution of each part.


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- 3.6 Any such plan or recommendation that is outside the scope of agreement shall be reduced to writing and referred to the management of each party for appropriate action.
- 3.7 Any such plan or recommendation so referred shall not be binding on either party unless incorporated into this agreement by amendment.
- 3.8 INNOVA, Nagpur and GNCP, Nagpur, may nominate members of their respective staff to work out the practical details of cooperation between the two organisations and in general, to ensure proper and effective implementation of this agreement. Such details, as agreed upon, will be confirmed by exchange of letters between the parties and such letters should be signed and acknowledged by both the parties and shall form part of this agreement.

4. TERM

This agreement will be in effect initially for a period of 3 (three) years from the date of signing of this agreement by both the parties and may be renewed further if mutually agreed. Either party may terminate the agreement by written notification signed by the appropriate official of the institution initiating the notice. Such notice must be received by the other party 3 (three) months prior to the effective termination date.

Termination of this agreement shall not affect the obligation as stated under Clause-5 and Clause-7 of this agreement and the same shall be binding on the parties in perpetuity.

5. CONFIDENTIALITY

5.1. Proprietary Business Information:

Each organization acknowledges and agrees that its fellow organizations are engaged in business, research activities in which it is or may be crucial to develop and retain proprietary, trade secrets, and other confidential information for the benefit of the both organizations (collectively, "proprietary information"). Accordingly, no organization shall at any time during or after the termination of this MOU, either directly or indirectly,

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5.1.1. Divulge or convey any proprietary information to any entity or individual, except as may be expressly authorized in writing by its fellow organization during or following the completion of the contractual relationship; or

5.1.2. Use any proprietary information for the organization's own benefit or the benefit of any entity or individual other than the organization owning the proprietary information. The proprietary information to which the collaborating organization may have access may include, but is not limited to, matters of a technical or intellectual nature such as inventions, designs, drawings, models, plans, improvements, processes of discovery, techniques, methods, ideas, discoveries, developments, know-how, formulae, compounds, compositions, specifications, specialized knowledge. The owner of such proprietary information shall mark all documents it considers covered by the clause as confidential before providing them to its collaborator.

5.2. Proprietary Personal Information:

During the course of collaborations, either entity may have access to private and personal information regarding their partners, its suppliers, customers, management, and shareholders, including, but not limited to, information regarding their personal, legal, or business affairs. INNOVA and GNCP, Nagpur understands and agree that the disclosure of any information whatsoever regarding the partner could be damaging. Each institution therefore agrees not to disclose any such information to any person or entity including the media during or after the term of this MOU, except as required for the purposes of fulfilling the requirements of specific collaborations or as expressly authorized by the partner institution in writing, or as required by law.

6. INDEMNIFICATION

6.1 GNCP, Nagpur, shall indemnify and hold INNOVA Ltd, Nagpur harmless from liability resulting from the negligent acts or omissions of GNCP, Nagpur, its agents or employees pertaining to the activities to be carried out pursuant to the obligations of this agreement; provided however, that GNCP, Nagpur, shall not hold INNOVA, Nagpur harmless from claims arising out of the negligence or wilful malfeasance of INNOVA, Nagpur, its officers, agents, or employees, or any person or entity not subject to GNCP, Nagpur's, supervision or control.

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6.2 INNOVA, Nagpur shall indemnify and hold GNCP, Nagpur, harmless from any liability or loss resulting from judgments or claims against them arising out of the activities to be carried out pursuant to the obligation of this agreement, including but not limited to the use by INNOVA, Nagpur of the results of the study/research; provided however, that the following is excluded from INNOVA, Nagpur's obligation to indemnify and hold harmless;

6.4 The negligence or willful malfeasance by an officer, agent, or employee of Innoova Pvt Ltd, Nagpur and GNCP, Nagpur.

7. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

7.1 "Invention" shall mean any discovery, concept, or idea, whether or not patentable, made during the conduct of the study/research, and arising directly from the performance of the study/research, including but not limited to processes, methods, software, tangible research products, formulas and techniques, improvements thereto, and know-how related thereto.

7.2 It is recognized and understood that the existing inventions and technologies of INNOVA, Nagpur and GNCP, Nagpur, are their separate property, respectively and are not affected by this agreement and neither party shall have any claims to or rights in such existing inventions and technologies of the other party. The parties agree that all Intellectual Property, jointly developed by GNCP, Nagpur and INNOVA, Nagpur or acquired jointly by GNCP, Nagpur and INNOVA, Nagpur while undertaking the objects of this agreement shall be the joint property of GNCP and INNOVA, Nagpur.

8. RELATIONSHIP OF PARTIES

INNOVA, Nagpur and GNCP, Nagpur, shall act in their independent capacities in the performance of their respective functions under this Agreement and no party is to be considered the officer, agent, or employee of another party.


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9. GOVERNING LAW

This agreement shall be governed and construed in accordance with the laws of India and jurisdiction limited to courts at Nagpur, India.

10. ARBITRATION

10.1 Any disputes or disagreement, arising out of, relating to or in connection with the terms and conditions of this agreement whether during the subsistence of this agreement or after its termination, shall be amicably settled between the parties hereto by mutual discussions.

10.2 If the disputes cannot be amicably settled by mutual discussions then, either party, as soon as practicable, but not earlier than one month after a request to settle the dispute amicably has been made to the other party, give to the other party notice in writing of existence of such question, dispute or difference, specifying the nature and the point at issue and the same shall be finally settled and decided in accordance with the Indian Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996. The venue for arbitration shall be at Nagpur, India.

11. PUBLICATIONS

11.1 The parties reserve the right to publish or otherwise make public the data resulting from the study. The party wishing to publish or make public shall submit any such manuscript or release to the other party for comment prior to publication or release.

11.2 Neither GNCP, Nagpur, nor INNOVA, Nagpur shall use the name of the other party or any of its employees in connection with any press release, advertising, promotional literature, or any other publicity matters without the express prior written consent of the other.

11.3 Except as otherwise required by law or regulation, neither party shall release or distribute any materials or information containing the name of the other party or any of


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its employees without prior written approval by an authorized representative of the non-releasing party, but such approval shall not be unreasonably withheld.

12. NOTICES

All notices required to be given under this agreement and all correspondence with regard to any such notice hereunder shall be in writing and delivered in person, sent by certified mail or telefax transmission to the individuals named.

13. AMENDMENT

This agreement may be amended and renewed by the mutual written consent of the parties hereto.

14. SEVERABILITY


The invalidity or unenforceability of any term or provision of this agreement shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other term or provision hereof.

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and causes thereof shall be given immediately by the affected Party to the other Party.

- (b) A Party may claim exemption from the timely performance of obligations due to the occurrence of Force Majeure as defined above. In order to claim such exemption and thus be excused from timely performance of obligations, notice must be given promptly to the other Party and at the earliest possible date of event of occurrence of Force Majeure.
- (c) A Party claiming relief by reason of such circumstances of Force Majeure must take all reasonable steps to mitigate their length and effect. Promptly after the termination of the circumstances of Force Majeure, the Party claiming relief shall forthwith notify the other Party in writing.


17. COUNTERPARTS



4.2 Both Parties may terminate this MOU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing. In the event of Termination, both parties have to discharge their obligations


CLAUSE 5 RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES


Brief introduction of both parties:
