The main motto was to expose teachers to entrepreneurship development process and equip them to develop, vision, strategy and structures for entrepreneurship development activity in their colleges and the content was based on :

- Skills and behavior training
- Business opportunity identification
- Communication and leadership
- Creativity and innovation

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- Resources building
- Information on entrepreneurship support organization
- Support institutions and banking
- Interaction with successful entrepreneur and industry leaders

Resource persons:- The resource person invited were experienced entrepreneur manageable person from industry, eminent academicians, advisers, policy makers, subject expert from research and development, government officials, patent attorney, innovators, financial institution and the persons working in the area of SMEs development conducted sessions for the program to give a holistic perspective on the topic. The program was well accepted from the teachers' community and the faculty from various institutions turned out in large numbers.

The certificates were given to the participants for successfully completed the training program by qualifying in the criteria that is 60% marks in quizzes conducted and 90% attendance. Participation was 70 in STTP 1, 44 in STTP II and 49 in STTP II. In all 163 participants completed training program successfully even though the registered participant were 210.
